The Royal [Institute of the Architects](#) of Ireland (RIAI) and the Simon Communities have launched the thirteenth annual RIAI Simon Open Door campaign. RIAI Registered Architects across the country will offer one hour consultations to the public for a donation of €90.00, every cent of which goes directly to the Simon Communities in Ireland. Since the campaign began in 2004 over €600,000 has been raised by the Irish public and registered architects. Home-owners are being called on to log on to www.simonopendoor.ie to book a one-hour consultation with an RIAI registered architect in their area. All participating architects are giving their time and expertise for free.

RIAI Simon Open Door will take place for one week commencing Saturday, 13th May – Friday 19th May 2017.
