The Mallow Heritage Group are delighted to announce that their project, entitled "Mallow Urban Heritage Masterplan. Phase 1: Thomas Davis Square" is one of three finalist for the **RIAI** Awards, public space/masterplan category.

The Public Choice Award, as part of this process, gives the public an opportunity to vote for their favourite project. Clonakilty 400 masterplan, designed by the Architects Department, won the Public Choice award in 2014 with over 12,000 votes.
