Works At Lynally Medieval Church

LYNALLY medieval church, close to Tullamore and Mucklagh, is undergoing conservation work currently.

Contractors moved on site on Monday ,12th September to sta-

blise the masonry and make the church safe to visit.

In 2015 Mucklagh Development Association secured Heritage Council Community Grant funding and Margaret Quinlan Architects, **RIAI** Conservation Grade 1, were appointed with the David Kelly Partnership to advise on Lynally Church and to prepare documentation.

This has led to Ministerial consent for works being received and a grant €26,750 from the Stuctures at Risk Fund from the Department and an allocation from Offaly County Council.

Weather permitting the works should be done by the end of the year. Please note under Health and Safety there are to be no site visits from interested historians until all works are completed and contractors have left the site.

Sincere thanks to Matthew Mooney, who owns the surrounding lands, for facilitating and welcoming the conservation team. Thanks also to Darrell Hooper for his work via Mucklagh Development Association.
